COISTE

Coiste is the student Council in St Louis with students elected from each year group. Coiste provides an opportunity for students to make their voices heard, they meet regularly, organise events for students and work in partnership with school management, teachers and parents for the benefit of the students and St Louis.

Guidance & Counselling in St Louis Guidance In St Louis Secondary School.

Guidance refers to a range of learning experiences in a developmental sequence

to assist students to make choices about their lives and how to make transitions consequent to these choices. These learning experiences are delivered through four separate yet interlinked categories which are personal, educational, social and career. In St. Louis Secondary School we are mindful of the demands and challenges facing our students. The Board of Management in recognising this has appointed a counsellor to the school two days per week to help students navigate through difficult times or experiences in their lives. These sessions are free to the students.

What is counselling? Counselling is a type of talk therapy that aims to help students work through any problems or difficulties they may be having in their lives. These difficulties might include stress, anxiety, low mood, grief, relationship problems, friendship issues, family difficulties or school matters. Counselling is a confidential and safe space to hear yourself think out loud about your life, express how you're really feeling and discuss concerns and worries with someone who won't judge you. Students can email the counsellor directly at julie@stlouismonaghan.com to arrange a session time or speak to any member of staff who will pass your name to the counsellor.



1st Year Settling In Programme & Cairde Friendly Face Programme. All new 1st Year students to St Louis complete a structured settling in programme with their Year head, tutors and HSL teacher. The girls are also paired up to a 'Cairde', a transition year student who will become their check and connect contact throughout the year. The Cairde will be there to provide advice, answer any questions or queries that will arise, help you find your way around and guide you through your first exciting year in St Louis Secondary School.

The Transition Year programme in St. Louis has been devised for the enrichment of students' learning experiences, with the purpose of laying a solid foundation for the Leaving Certificate. Each St. Louis Ty student has the opportunity to develop their own skills and talents, and to apply them diligently in a process of independent learning. The St. Louis TY programme promotes education for maturity, with an emphasis on social awareness and social competence. Our TY programme also promotes the general, technical and academic skills, with a particular emphasis on inter-disciplinary and self-directed learning.

Leaving Certificate Results 2023

Following in the St Louis tradition our students again obtained exceptional Leaving certificate results, far exceeding the national average in most subjects. All higher level Maths students achieved the all important 25bonus CAO points.

The LC class of 2023 had 7% achieving over 600 CAO points, 23% over 500 CAO points 58% over 400 CAO points, 82% over 300 CAO points. Well done to our students and we wish them all the very best as they progress on to University and third level.
